#### **BLUE/GREEN SCHEDULE INFORMATION**

Upper School (Middle and High School only) has implemented a modified block schedule one week each month. During these weeks, students will attend their normal schedule on Monday, Tuesday, and Wednesday (7 periods per day, 50 minutes per class). On Thursday, students will attend periods 1 - 3, each class will be 90-minutes long and students will be dismissed at 12:45 p.m. On Friday, students will attend periods 4 - 7, each class will be 90 minutes long and students will be dismissed at 3:00 p.m. Students will eat lunch at school.
